**TITLE:** “The Compelling Voice of Jesus”

**TEXT:** John 7:40-46

**INTRODUCTION:** Revelation 1:15 says “His voice was as the sound of many waters.”  
Let us hear what that voice says to us today!

I: “UNLESS YOU REPENT, YOU WILL ALL LIKEWISE PERISH” (Luke 13:5)

II: “YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART,  
WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND” (Matthew 22:37)

III: “COME TO ME, ALL YOU WHO LABOR AND ARE HEAVY LADEN, AND I  
WILL GIVE YOU REST” (Matthew 11:28)

IV: “FOR WHAT IS A MAN PROFITED IF HE GAINS THE WHOLE WORLD,  
AND LOSES HIS OWN SOUL?” (Matthew 16:26)

**CONCLUSION:** Please consider two more of His statements from the Gospels ...

“LOVE YOUR ENEMIES, BLESS THOSE WHO CURSE YOU, DO GOOD TO  
THOSE WHO HATE YOU, AND PRAY FOR THOSE WHO SPITEFULLY  
USE YOU AND PERSECUTE YOU” (Matthew 5:44)

“IN MY FATHER’S HOUSE ARE MANY MANSIONS; IF IT WERE NOT SO,  
WOULD HAVE TOLD YOU. I GO TO PREPARE A PLACE FOR YOU.  
AND IF I GO AND PREPARE A PLACE FOR YOU, I WILL COME AGAIN  
AND RECEIVE YOU TO MYSELF; THAT WHERE I AM, THERE YOU  
MAY BE ALSO” (John 14:2-3)
